Aero Ground School



As part of your PPL you are required to undertake 9 theory exams: Air Law, Human Performance & Limitations, Meteorology, Communications, Navigation, Flight Performance and Planning, Aircraft General Knowledge, Principles of Flight, Operational Procedures.

Air Law The first exam, covering legal requirements. Must be taken before going solo.

Human Performance & Limitations

Covering our relationship with flight safety and airmanship.

Meteorology gain a sound understanding of weather factors and learn to interpret these effectively for safe weather decisions.

Communications covering the theory side of communications including radiotelephony (RT) language and procedures.

Flight Performance & Planning Aircraft capabilities and limitations under differing circumstances

Aircraft General Knowledge

Structural, mechanical and

electrical functions of the aircraft.

Principles of Flight

The 'science part': covering the physics of flight and aerodynamics.

Navigation Learn the methods of calculation required and how to utilise navigational charts.

Operational Procedures Strong emphasis on safety in abiding by the rules and regulations of controlled airspace.

PPL Requirements



The CAA states that the following criteria must be met:

- The pass standard is 75%
- All theory exams must be taken within 6 'sittings' (a sitting being 10 day period).
- From completion of your first written exam, you have 18 months to complete the remaining 8 exams.
- You then have 24 months within which you must complete your flight training (including initial skills test).
- All written exams must be completed prior to undertaking your skills test.
- If your exams lapse before taking the skills test they have to be retaken.



All our Ground School tutors are also flight instructors and therefore have an unrivalled knowledge of the subject matter and how it works in practice.

All written exams must be sat and administered at ATO (Approved Training Organisation) such as Cambridge Aero Club.
